

North Carolina Junior Science and Humanities Symposium

A high school student research competition co-hosted by UNC Charlotte and UNC Wilmington

March 18 - 19, 2018 @ UNC Charlotte

- Up to four oral presenters and unlimited poster presenters, observers and teachers from a school may participate in the competition.
- Students may participate in the research competition (Papers and Posters) or come solely for the opportunity to experience a scientific research symposium.
- All hotel accommodations and meals will be provided **free of charge** by JSHS sponsors for registered teachers and students.
- Teachers must arrange for transportation for themselves and their students to and from Charlotte.

Top 5 Winners from the NC JSHS will advance (all expenses covered) to the 56th National Junior Science and Humanities Symposium (JSHS).

The Academy of Applied Sciences will distribute \$4,500 in academic scholarships to the top three regional finalists:

\$2,000 to first place
\$1,500 to second place
\$1,000 to third place

A \$500 award to one teacher at the regionals, honoring the individual teacher's and his or her school's contributions to advancing student participation in research.
